
HOW TO SIGN UP FOR A VACCINE APPOINTMENT:

Go to:



Please note, only one member of your household needs to do this. Not both.

STEP 1. Make an account by clicking on the Create a new account link



STEP 2: Put in ALL of your information. It's ok. This is a trusted site. Once you have entered all of your information, press the red "Sign up" button. This is very important. Once you press the sign up button. The screen doesn't really do anything. It kind of looks like nothing happened, except that the info that you typed in isn't there anymore. BUT, your account was created. How do we know?...



STEP 3. CHECK YOUR EMAIL


This is how we know you created your account. You will get an email that looks like this...

CHECK YOUR SPAM/JUNK MAIL IF YOU DO NOT SEE THIS EMAIL. Cox.net addresses have this problem a lot of times. The email will be there. If you cannot find it, search in your email for azdhs. It should find it for you

Click on the link to set up a password.



STEP 4. Make your password



The link will take you to this page. Type in the email account you used to sign up and press "Send Verification Code". This will send a verification code to your email address.

GO BACK TO YOUR EMAIL and get the verification code. You can certainly type it in to the website, but your best bet it to COPY AND PASTE IT. You do this by selecting the code and right clicking and choosing copy or by pressing ctrl and the C key


(You can send yourself a new code if you can't find the first email, but you should wait at least 5 minutes until you use that option. It can be confusing if there are 2 emails with different verification codes.)

Once you press verify code, it will say that the code was verified and you can press the continue button. It will then ask you to make your passcode. The password has to be between 8-16 characters, containing 3 out of 4 of the following: Lowercase characters, uppercase characters, digits (0-9), and one or more of the following symbols: @ #

\$ % ^ & * - _ + = [] {} | \:',?/`~"();.

STEP 5: ONCE YOU HAVE MADE YOUR PASSWORD, it will go back to that login screen. It will not say password confirmed or anything. If it goes to the login screen, your password was made. So then you press Login, enter your email address you used to sign up and the password you just made.


It will take you into the scheduling site which looks like this:



Click on Schedule a Vaccination.

STEP 6: Enter All of the information they ask for. Don't forget to scroll down for the next button and for all of the questions and information.


You are scheduling this appointment for yourself. NOTE: If there is someone else in your household, you can make an appointment for them afterwards by selecting Dependent/Family Member.




- Scroll down and click NEXT.
- In vaccine group, click the box next to COVID-19 and click on next.
- Answer all of the supplemental questions honestly. If it is not yet your time for the vaccine, that's ok. It will be your time soon. Currently those 75+, professional educators and health care workers are able to sign up.
- Type in all of the personal information they ask for. You will not be able to register without answering all of the questions.
- Do you have insurance? You can type in your insurance info or not. You will not be denied a
 vaccine if you do not have insurance.

STEP 7. SCHEDULING


Choose a date that is convenient for you and click Search. If there are appointments available that day, the screen will look like this...




Click on the circle next to the location that you'd like to go to in order to receive your vaccine. Cardinal's Stadium is the "State of Arizona POD – Glendale" location. That location is open 24 hours.



Once you click on the location you'd like, click the Next button. This is what the page will look like:



Click on the little link that says "Select Shot". (Do not click the "Next Button" just yet. A pop up will come up that will give you time options. It looks like this:




Click on the timeframe you'd like... it will look like this...




Click on the time you'd like. (if you will be scheduling someone else in your household, you will want to choose one of the times that has a larger number of slots so it will be there when you register your other person)

SCROLL ALL THE WAY DOWN ON THE POP UP AND CLICK SAVE.



Once you do that, your screen will look like this (with the time you selected...




NOW YOU CAN CLICK NEXT.

Step 8: Continue filling out the information.

- Answer all of the screening questions truthfully
- · Confirm that there is consent
- · Finally confirm that you want to get the vaccine

CLICK NEXT.

- 9. How do you know your appointment was confirmed?
 - · you will get an email confirmation
 - Your main screen will look like this...



If you need to schedule another appointment for someone in your household, you can click on Schedule a vaccination and choose that you are making the appointment for a Dependent/Family Member. They must be in the current vaccine group in order to see available appointments.

WHAT TO DO ON VACCINATION DAY:

- Print out or have on your smart phone the email they sent you as a confirmation. (there is a QR code and appointment ID on there they will need)
- 2. Don't forget to bring your ID.
- Bring a mask.
- 4. If you are not feeling well, DO NOT GET YOUR VACCINE. You can go back online to reschedule your appointment (rescheduling is super easy)
- 5. Arrive 15 minutes early
- 6. Get your vaccine!

They will let you know when and how to get the second dose you will need to get in order for the vaccine to be fully effective. Don't forget to get your second shot as well.
